1. All program registrations are non-refundable and non-transferrable.
2. Transportation to & from Mt. Southington is by the authorized YMCA bus transportation only. No parent pick-up/drop off is allowed unless prior authorization is received by the Y-Ski Club Director. A signed note is required by the parent.
3. Participants shall stay with a buddy/partner at all times.
4. There shall be no loud or disruptive behavior while on the bus or at the ski area (as determined by the chaperones or bus driver).
5. Inappropriate behavior or language will lead to suspension or dismissal from the ski club program. The determination will be at the discretion of the director and chaperones. If such is necessary, no refund will be issued for any absence from the program.
6. The use of any illegal substances is strictly prohibited. This includes alcohol, cigarettes, drugs, etc. Anyone being suspected of using or caught using any illegal substances will be dismissed from the ski club program, with no refund.
7. I have read and understand the procedure for ski/snowboard make-ups as stated in the *Group Waiver form*.
8. I have read and understand the Mt. Southington refund policy as stated in the *Group Waiver form*.
9. The Berlin YMCA is not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged equipment.
10. The Berlin YMCA is not responsible for any injuries that occur as a result of participation in the Y-Ski Club Program.

I have read, understand, and agree to the above information and give permission for my child to participate in the Berlin YMCA Ski Club Program to be held at Mt. Southington Ski Area, located in Southington, CT.

### EQUIPMENT RENTAL AND LIABILITY RELEASE AGREEMENT

**I understand that the ski binding system cannot guarantee the user's safety.** In downhill skiing, the binding system will not release at times or under all circumstances where release may prevent injury, nor is it possible to predict every situation in which it will release. In snowboarding or snow blade use, the binding system will not ordinarily release during use; these bindings are not designed to release as a result of forces generated during ordinary operation.

I hereby accept the rental skis or snowboard noted on reverse side. I verify that the visual indicators on my bindings correspond to the setting on the rental form. I feel the binding adjustment is proper for me. No misrepresentations have been made regarding my height, weight, age or ability. I recognize that any binding may not release under certain falls and recognize the fact that there is an inherent danger in the use of any ski or snowboard equipment. I agree to hold the equipment manufacturer, Mount Southington Ski Area, Inc., and Mount Southington Limited Partnership and its owners, officers, agents and employees harmless and blameless of any accident or injury which I might receive related to the use of the equipment. I agree to reimburse the lessor for any loss or damage of equipment other than normal wear. All instruction of the use of the equipment has been made clear to me and I understand the function of the equipment.

**MOUNT SOUTHLINGTON SKI AREA  
WAIVER OF CLAIMS, ASSUMPTION OF RISK, RELEASE OF LIABILITY,  
INDEMNIFICATION AND ARBITRATION AGREEMENT (2021/2022)**

**PLEASE READ CAREFULLY**

Skiing, snowboarding, and related activities involve risk of serious injury, including death, caused by hazards inherent in these the sports. Participation in these sports and related activities, no matter what type of equipment you are using or the event or program in which you have chosen to participate, including but not limited to racing training, racing competitions, terrain park use, terrain park competitions, lessons, group programs, cardboard box events, and others, is a voluntary act on the part of the Participant and, where applicable the Participant's parent(s) or guardian(s). The use of helmets is strongly recommended but cannot itself prevent serious injury or death.

In consideration of being allowed to take part in activities and services offered at Mount Southington Ski Area, Inc. (the "Facility"), the Participant, and the Participant's parent(s) or legal guardian(s) if the Participant is a minor, and on behalf of family members, heirs, and assigns (the "Releasor"), hereby agree, to the fullest extent permitted by law:

- 1) TO WAIVE ALL CLAIMS** that they have or may have against the Facility, Mount Southington Limited Partnership, and/or Mount Southington Restaurant and Lounge, Inc. ("Releasees") arising out of the inherent risks of skiing, snowboarding, and other related activities, such as mentioned above;
- 2) TO ASSUME ALL RISKS INHERENT TO SKIING, SNOWBOARDING AND OTHER RELATED ACTIVITIES**, as mentioned above; and
- 3) TO RELEASE AND INDEMNIFY RELEASEES**, their owners, affiliates, officers, directors, employees, agents, and shareholders, from all liability for any loss, damage, injury, death, or expense that the Participant (or their next of kin) may suffer, arising out of the inherent risks.

RELEASOR knows that these inherent risks include, but are not limited to the risks identified by the Connecticut legislature in Connecticut General Statutes (CGS) § 29-212 such as: variations in terrain and snow surfaces; bare spots or ice; trees or other objects not within the confines of the trails; collisions with race gates, terrain park features, or conspicuously marked or placed lift towers; or collisions with other skiers/riders. RELEASOR acknowledges that these inherent risks, among others that may be encountered in a winter alpine environment, could cause injuries, damages, or death. RELEASOR knows that skiing, snowboarding and related activities are inherently hazardous sports, and that participants commonly and routinely injure themselves while engaging in them. RELEASOR freely assumes the risk for all injuries, damages, or death caused by, or related to, these inherent risks. The Participant agrees to be at all times familiar with, and to follow, the Skier Responsibility Code, and to be familiar with, and to comply with the RELEASEES' rules, policies and any special regulations. The Participant acknowledges and agrees that it is their responsibility to close the restraining device on chair lifts, as referenced in CGS § 29-213. RELEASOR acknowledges that they have been adequately notified that child Participants may ride chair lifts with other children or non-employee adults, and consent to this.

RELEASOR agrees to indemnify and hold harmless the RELEASEES for all defense costs, fees, settlements, judgments and the like, including attorney fees, arising out of any claim that is related to injuries caused by the inherent risks.

RELEASOR agrees that every term and provision of this contract is intended to be severable. If any one or more of them is found to be unenforceable or invalid, that shall not affect the other terms and provisions, which shall remain binding and enforceable on RELEASOR.

**Arbitration:** RELEASOR and RELEASEES agree that any claim for personal injury or death, except claims for indemnification, shall be submitted for arbitration. Three arbitrators, including one neutral, shall be utilized. They shall decide if the injuries and damages claimed by RELEASOR arise out of risks inherent to skiing, snowboarding, and related activities. RELEASOR agrees to abide by the arbitrators' decision, and refrain from pursuing damages by way of civil lawsuit, if the arbitrators determine that RELEASOR'S injuries or damages arose out of said inherent risks. If the arbitrators determine that the RELEASOR'S injuries and damages did not arise out of an inherent risk, RELEASOR may pursue the claim by way of civil law suit in either state or federal court and RELEASEE will not pursue inherent risk as a defense at trial of the civil suit.

**Acknowledgement:** I grant permission to Mount Southington Ski Area, Inc. to use my photograph, video recording, motion picture recording, or any other record of my use of its services for legitimate advertising purposes.

This agreement represents the entire agreement between the parties, and it may not be altered or modified, except by written modification signed by the parties.

I HAVE READ AND UNDERSTAND THIS AGREEMENT, AND I AM AWARE THAT BY SIGNING THIS AGREEMENT I MAY BE WAIVING CERTAIN LEGAL RIGHTS, INCLUDING THE RIGHT TO SUE. I CONSENT TO SIGN THE AGREEMENT/ACCEPT TERMS ELECTRONICALLY AND HAVE BEEN GIVEN AMPLE TIME TO CONSIDER THESE TERMS.

Thanks for registering your child for the Berlin YMCA Ski Club. Here's a list of helpful information to make everyone's Ski Club experience enjoyable. Please feel free to contact me with any questions.

- **Snacks/Dinner:** Participants can purchase food or bring their own. Bring food in disposable food bags. No lunch boxes, coolers, etc. Participants that bring their own food money are responsible for it. The YMCA is not responsible for lost food money. Everyone will get time to go in groups to the food area and will be expected to check-in with the Chaperone in the lodge.
- **Ski/Snowboard Lessons:** Those participants that have registered for lessons are expected to take their lessons unless the director/chaperone has received a note from a parent excusing that child from doing the lesson. Mt. Southington Staff coordinate all lessons and a Ski Club chaperone will escort children to the lesson area when we arrive.
- **Upon arrival to Mt. Southington:** We secure a "home area" in the ski lodge where participants will keep all their belongings (bags & shoes, etc.) Label all items with your child's name. All participants are responsible for their belongings.
- **Dress appropriately! Gloves and a hat are a must!** It's always a lot colder at the mountain. Ski pants are highly recommended. Helmets are recommended by Mt. Southington, but not required. Other suggested items include warm socks, a turtleneck, a scarf or neck tube, ski goggles or sunglasses, and a ski parka/coat. Goggles or sunglasses are extremely important especially when there is new snow.
- **Participants bringing their own equipment:** Each school will have a list of those participating in the Ski Club. If your child has their own equipment, please check with your school office as we will have made arrangements for the equipment to be put somewhere safe until the end of the school day. Please make sure all equipment is secure before and labeled.
- **Supervision & Safety:** We use the buddy system at all times when at Mt. Southington. We ask that parents help reinforce the importance of staying with the group and with a buddy at all times. It's best if participants group themselves with others that are able to ski/snowboard on the same hill which is based on skill level. Also all participants will be instructed on the first day that they must check-in every hour with the Ski-Club chaperone stationed in the lodge. This is done every week, on the hour, every hour. Anyone that does not follow the check-in rules will be asked to come off the mountain and will have ski/snowboard time taken away that same day or at the next scheduled ski club day.

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- **New skiers/snowboarders** are not allowed to progress to larger hills unless their Lesson Instructor brings them to the larger hills with lessons or they have been "tested" and then ski with a YMCA chaperone. If participants are unsure of where they can ski they should ask a Mt. Southington Staff member or Y Ski Club chaperone.
- **Cancellations and communication:** If one of the Y-Ski Club days is cancelled due to inclement weather or extreme cold, an email blast and automated phone call message will be sent to parents by 11:00 a.m. of the scheduled ski club day. The email will be sent to the email address you provided on the registration form. You can opt in to receive a text message by texting the word Alert to 22300.

All Schools will be notified of the cancellation as well. Please note that every effort will be made for a make-up day to be offered. We will receive the makeup date from Mt. Southington and then notify the parents and participants via email and call once again.
