## Additional Information:

- On scheduled "no school" days we offer **Fun Days** at the New Britain YMCA at 50 High St., at an additional cost (not including major holidays). Details are available two weeks prior to the no school day.
- Take advantage of our **Snow Day Club** - which offers care at the YMCA, at an additional cost, on those days when school is cancelled due to inclement weather. Registration begins in November.

## Registration Information:

- To register please complete the required registration forms (1 set per child). Registration forms are available online at [www.nbbymca.org](http://www.nbbymca.org) or in person at the YMCA. Bring the forms, along with a current copy of the child's current physical form with immunization records to the New Britain YMCA, 50 High St.
- At the time of registration the child registering must already be or obtain a \$33 Program Membership. There is also a one-time \$30 registration fee.
- Weekly payments are required to be set-up by auto-draft to either a credit/debit card or bank account. With the weekly payments you are always paying for the week ahead for care.

## Why the Y?

As a partner with the Consolidated School District of New Britain, the YMCA is proud to offer **before and after school care** in 9 of the Elementary Schools: Lincoln, Vance, Smith, Smalley, Northend, Gaffney, Jefferson, Holmes, & Chamberlain. At Diloreto school we **offer after school care only.**

Our well-trained and qualified staff will engage your children in a wide variety of activities including homework time, arts and crafts, outdoor play, cooperative games, sports, and more! Our programs focus on the fundamentals of the YMCA core values of Caring, Honesty, Respect and Responsibility.

## What are the costs?

### AM (Before) Care:

**\$32 per week /per child**

- Starts at 7:00 a.m. until school begins
- Offered in all schools except Diloreto
- *Program cancelled when there's a delayed opening of school*

### PM (After) Care

**\$47 per week/per child**

- Starts at school dismissal until 6:00pm.
- Offered in all schools including Diloreto.

### Combo (Before & After Care)

**\$62 per week /per child**

- Same times as above
- Offered in all schools except Diloreto

\*Care 4 Kids is accepted.

\*\*Financial Assistance may be available to those who qualify.

## What's included?

- Set daily schedule that allows for homework to be completed.
- Group games, outdoor play, arts & crafts, sports, and more!
- Enrichment activities such as Yoga, STEM, fitness, and more!
- Afternoon dinner for Aftercare participants (provided by the district).
- On half days of school we provide care for those that are in the Aftercare or Combo Care programs. Care starts at the half-day dismissal up until 6pm.
